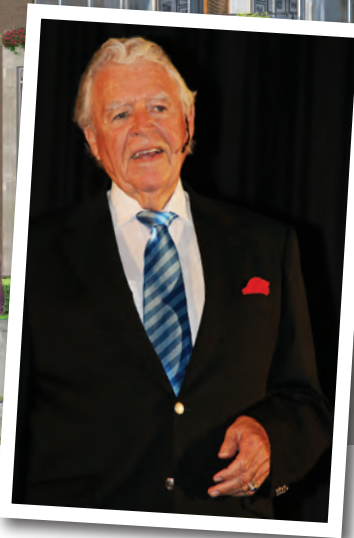


Retirement Brings *New Beginnings*
